### **Got Chainsaws?**

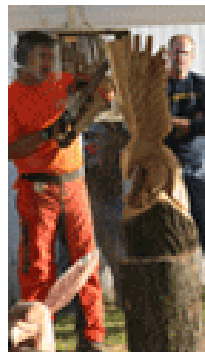
When you think of chainsaws what do you think of?
