

Vendor/Crafters Space Details

- All vendors/crafters must have proof of insurance before anyone is allowed to set up.
- Commercial, Food and Non-Profits can start setting any time after 9am Tuesday July 6th. Everyone must be set by 9pm. For special arrangements please contact Lori Arnolds.
- Crafters can start setting up any time after 6:00 a.m. on Saturday, July 10th. All crafters must be set up by 9:00 am Saturday and Sunday morning and stay open until 1/2 hour after the grandstand event each night.
- Recommended Hours for Commercial, Food and Non-Profits to be open:
 - Wednesday July 7th 9am to to 1/2 hour after grandstand event ends;
 - Thursday July 8th 9am to to 1/2 hour after grandstand event ends;
 - Friday July 9th, 9pm to 1/2 hour after grandstand event ends;
 - Saturday July 10th, 9am to 1/2 hour after grandstand event ends
 - Sunday July 11th, 10am to 1/2 hour after grandstand event ends
 - Monday July 12th 4:30pm to 1/2 hour after grandstand event ends
- We encourage everyone to tie down tents, equipment and take any merchandise with them after the grand stand events each evening. Security will be limited. The Linn County Fair Association is not responsible for any stolen or damaged items, including items damaged by Mother Nature.
- Tear down start no earlier then 1/2 hour after grandstand event on your last day and no later then midnight on Monday, July 12th.
- Trash must be placed in dumpsters located near the grandstand each night
- You must provide your own tent, tables & chairs for outdoor spaces and table and chairs for indoor spaces and craft tent.
- Indoor vendor building will be locket 1/2 hour after grandstand event ends.
- Vendor vehicles parking lot is near front gate after set up and unloading. You must have vendor parking pass to be allowed to park on fair grounds
- Food vendors must have health permit and wash station. Linn County Health Department will be doing health inspection. Please see Lori Arnold for disposal of grey water.
- If your electrical power cords are in a high traffic area they must be covered for safety reasons.
