The Linn County Fair Association has for several years put into practice different environmentally friendly procedures which include:

- Recycling Bins placed throughout the fair grounds
- 4-H groups collecting and return cans and bottles
- Compost and mulch used for the gardens on the grounds
- **As** light bulbs burn out we replace them with energy efficient lighting
- We use wood chips for animal bedding
- Recycled Garden Art contest- 2nd annual
- Used Recycled Roof shingles to resurface fair roads.
- Use old paint that would have gone to land field to repaint buildings
