Linn County Farm Bureau Donates \$40K to Linn County Fair Project

The Linn County Farm Bureau donates forty thousand dollars to the Lynn Dunn Memorial Building Project at The Lynn Dunn Memorial Ground Breaking event. The event was held on Sunday, July 7th, 2013 at The Linn County Fair Grounds. The Lynn Dunn Memorial Building is projected to be completed Spring of 2014.

Jason Russell, President of the Linn County Farm Bureau, presented the check to Jenn Dunn and Deb Zumbach of the Linn County Fair Board. The donation will be split up in eight thousand dollar increments over the next five years. Jean Dunn expressed her gratitude to Farm Bureau and their continuous support of the fair and of Lynn Dunn's dreams. The Linn County Farm Bureau has been involved with the fair for many years, including sponsoring the Free Entertainment Tent at the fair since 2006.

Jason Russell, the Linn County Farm Bureau President, expressed why they donated to the Lynn Dunn Memorial Building, “Linn County Farm Bureau is a non-profit farm organization dedicated to helping farm families prosper and improve their quality of life. Helping to fund the year-round heated and air conditioned Lynn Dunn Memorial Building will encourage farm families to support the Linn County Fair Association and all that the association is doing to not only provide a facility for 4-H and FFA member farm families to use but also for other community members as well. We feel this facility is much needed in the community.”
