Rules

Photographs may be black and white or color. Photographs may be processed from slides, negatives, digital cameras and computer manipulation programs.

Photos may be mounted; they can be (a) flush mounted (no mounting board showing and on mounting board) or (b) with mount border. Photos may be matted.

If photos are not mounted, they may be exhibited in a clear plastic covering such as photo album page.

We will not accept framed photos.

Photo size 4x6, 5x7, 8x10, and 11x14 accepted.

All exhibitors are limited to no more than 2 entries per class, not to exceed 10 entries total.

Photos must be labeled on back with exhibitor name, address and phone number.

If number of exhibitors are adequate, classes may be divided into junior (12-17) and adult (18 and over).

Professionals may exhibit in the professional division.
