2017 Linn County Fair Parking

For the safety of all who attend our fair, it is necessary to limit parking on the fairgrounds. Please note that parking areas and designations in this document have changed since the map was printed in order to meet our growing needs. *Lot F parking is now for Staff & Fair Association Members. Your parking pass must be displayed appropriately in the front driver's side window.*

- ***All static and livestock exhibitors without trailers are to park in Lot B. There is absolutely NO PARKING along the fair road. This is for everyone's safety and to allow for easier access in case of an emergency.***
- ***No vehicles will be allowed past the Lynn Dunn Memorial building.***
- ***ALL trailer parking is located in Lot G and is accessible by using the park entrance then proceeding down the road and entering at Gate 5.***
- ***You may bring feed and supplies onto the grounds with your vehicle each day, as long as its before 8 AM. At 8 AM all vehicles will be asked to leave the grounds for the start of the fair day. If this becomes a problem the Fair Association reserves the right to change this at anytime.***
- ***You may NOT bring your own motorized equipment onto fairground property to unload tack.***

Monday June 26, 2017

9 AM to 7 PM Open Show Static Exhibitors (non 4-H/FFA) & **10:30 AM to 6 PM 4-H & FFA Static Exhibitors** needing to unload may enter at the west side of Gate 1, unload in the horseshoe around the Gate Building (building 1 on your map) and then immediately leave out the east side of Gate 1 & park in Lot B. If it is raining, unloading will be changed to protect the integrity of the projects!

Tuesday, June 27, 2017

Horse and Pony exhibitors need to enter at the park entrance and proceed down the road to Gate 4. Please exit the fairgrounds at Gate 2.

Livestock Exhibitors delivering tack enter using gate 4 and exiting through Gate 2. Staff at the gate will give you instructions as to how to proceed to your unloading destination.

Wednesday, June 28, 2017

All livestock exhibitors, check-in/unloading process will be the same as last year. Please enter using the IAS/Park entrance. Staff will direct you to your appropriate lines and then onto your unloading destination. If you have more than one species to unload, you will proceed out Gate 2, and go back around to Gate 4 to get back in line to unload your next species. It is important that you follow the request made by the committees in order for the check in process to go smoothly for all. Trailer parking is located in Lot G which is accessed by using the park road to Gate 5.

Thursday, June 29, 2017

Prior to 8 AM Youth Day Exhibits & Youth Day Exhibitors needing to unload at the Lynn Dunn Memorial or Garden Building need to enter at the west side of Gate 1, unload, exit at the east side of Gate 1, and park in Lot B. If arriving to unload after that time, please find personnel at Gate 1 to request a shuttle.

Livestock exhibitors except Kiddie Calf checking in today need to use the park entrance to proceed to Gate 4 where you will receive your unloading instructions. Once unloaded, proceed to exit the fairgrounds through Gate 2 and park your trailer in Lot G which is accessed using the park entrance to Gate 5. Exhibitors not needing trailer parking should park in Lot B.

Kiddie Calf exhibitor's with calves are to enter at Gate 4. Staff will give you directions to your unloading area. You are then permitted to park in the grassy area west of Barn 18. All vehicles & trailers must be removed from the premises within 1 hour of completion of the Kiddie Calf Show, exiting through Gate 2.

Staff & Food Vendor Parking - All staff and food vendors will receive parking passes designating their lots. All passes must be placed in the windshield on the driver side so that it is visible. Vendors will be limited to one vehicle and will park in Lot H, south of the Indoor Vending Area by entering at Gate 1. All other staff

will need to park in Lot H, south of the camping area, or in Lot F. If parking in Lot H south, you must enter through Gate 5.

Handicapped & Special Needs Parking - Parking is in Lot A & the vehicle must have the appropriate license plate or placard.

Fair Association Members - Parking is designated in Lot H south of the camping area or in Lot F.

Campers/Camping - Fair Board & Association Members & staff can bring in their campers on Saturday, June 24th, entering at Gate 5. Exhibitors & guests camping can arrive Sunday, June 25th between 10 AM and 6 PM, entering at Gate 5. Any campers entering Monday or Tuesday will need to enter through Gate 5. All campers must be on the fairgrounds by 7:00 PM Tuesday, June 27th. No campers will be allowed on the fairgrounds after that. All camping will be done west of the track in the designated camping area with no camping allowed anywhere else on the fairgrounds. Additional camping is available at the Wakpicada Natural Area behind the fairgrounds and at Pinicon Ridge County Park located northwest of Central City. Any vehicles accessing the camping area will need to enter through Gate 5 & drive on the back side of the track to the camping area. All campers must be out by 7:00 PM Monday, July 3rd. ***NOTE:** Weather may affect our parking and check-in procedures! If this does happen we will do our best to make suitable accommodations that are in the best interest of the fair and ALL of its attendees.
